COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA

1. Uniform Electronic Legal Material Act - Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report regarding this uniform act.
2. New Jersey Soldier's and Sailor's Civil Relief Act - Consideration of a proposed project to examine the federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act and the New Jersey Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act to determine whether the New Jersey law may require amendment.
3. Tuition Aid Grants – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report recommending a modification of *N.J.S. 18A:71B-2* (Student eligibility) as a result of the Court's determination in *A.Z. ex rel. B.Z. v. Higher Educ. Student Assistance Authority*, 427 N.J.Super. 389 (App. Div. 2012).
4. Pejorative Terms Regarding Persons with Physical or Sensory Disabilities – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report recommending elimination of pejorative language when referring to persons with physical or sensory disabilities.
5. Revised Uniform Law on Notarial Acts – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report combining language from New Jersey's current statute, the uniform act, and bills introduced in this area.
6. Title 2C – Sexual Offenses – Consideration of a Revised Tentative Report regarding this project.
7. Uniform Electronic Recordation of Custodial Interrogations Act - Consideration of the Uniform Electronic Recordation of Custodial Interrogations Act in light of R. 3:17, the related Attorney General guidelines, and *Winberry v. Salisbury*.
8. Uniform Deployed Parents Custody and Visitation Act - Consideration of Draft Final Report recommending no action be taken with regard to the uniform act.
