1. Title 9 – Children; Abused, Neglected and Dependent Children – Further consideration of a Draft Final Report and Memorandum with comments from the Department of Children and Families and the Office of Law Guardian.
2. Underground Facility Protection Act, N.J.S. 48:2-80 subsec. d. – Consideration of a Draft Final Report incorporating revisions authorized at the last Commission meeting.
3. Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project clarifying statutory language in response to *In re New Jersey Dep't of Env'tl. Prot. Conditional Highlands Applicability Determination, Program Interest No. 435434*.
4. Long-Term Capacity Pilot Project Act (LCAPP) – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project amending the LCAPP in response to the recent Federal District Court decision in *PPL EnergyPlus, LLC v. Hanna*.
5. Clarification of Tenure Issues - Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project that arose as the result of three cases interpreting the language of N.J.S. 18A:17-2 including *DiNapoli v. Board of Education of the Township of Verona*.
6. Uniform Act on Prevention of and Remedies for Human Trafficking – Consideration of a Memorandum regarding the incorporation of certain Uniform Act provisions into New Jersey law.
7. Uniform Protection of Genetic Information in Employment Act – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report proposing revisions to existing New Jersey law in response to the Uniform Protection of Genetic Information in Employment Act.
8. Tuition Aid Grant Act – Memorandum recommending the conclusion of the work of the Commission in this area in light of Legislative action.
