### **COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA**

1. Uniform Protection of Genetic Information in Employment Act – Consideration of a Draft Final Report recommending incorporation of certain provisions of the Uniform Act in to New Jersey’s existing Genetic Privacy Act.
2. Expungement – Consideration of Memorandum proposing a project revising the law pertaining to expungement in response to the determination of the Court in *In re D.J.B.*, 216 N.J. 433 (2014).
3. Seatbelt use – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to consider modifying statutory language to address the interplay between N.J.S. 39:3-76.2f (seat belt statute) and N.J.S. 2C:40-18 (public health and safety statute) in response to the Court decision in *State v. Lenihan*, 219 N.J. 251 (2014).
4. Nursing Home Responsibilities and Residents’ Rights Act – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to consider modifying the language of N.J.S. 30:13-4.2 in response to the determination of the Court in *Ptasynski v. Atlantic Health Systems, Inc.*, 440 N.J. Super 24, (App. Div. 2015).
5. Local Redevelopment and Housing Law – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to research and clarify the statutory language in response to the Court’s decision in *62-64 Main Street, L.L.C. v. Mayor and Council of City of Hackensack*, 221 N.J. 129-36 (2015).
6. Uniform Common Interest Ownership Act – Consideration of a Memorandum reflecting the Commission’s tentative determinations so far and containing additional provisions from the 2007 Uniform Act for the Commission’s review.
7. New Jersey Filial Responsibility Statutes – Consideration of a Memorandum updating the Commission regarding the actions of other states with respect to their filial responsibility laws.
