### **COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA**

1. Retroactive Child Support Orders – Consideration of a Memorandum relating to the Commission’s Retroactive Child Support Orders project, discussing comment on a recent Tentative Report and potential expansion of the project’s scope.
2. Liability; Weather related public streets and highways – N.J.S. 59:4-7 - Consideration of Memorandum proposing a project to revise N.J.S. 59:4-7, which governs the liability of public entities for injuries resulting from weather-related road conditions, in response to the concurring opinion in *Pico v. State*, 116 N.N. 53 (1989).
3. Expungement – Consideration of Draft Tentative Report proposing revisions to expungement provision codified in N.J.S. 2C:52-4.1(a) in response to the determination of the Court in *In re D.J.B.*, 216 N.J. 433 (2014).
4. State v. Bessey - N.J.S. 2C:33-7b – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project based upon the Appellate Division decision considering the mental state that must be proved in order to find that a defendant committed the offense of “obstructing highways and other public passages” pursuant to N.J.S. 2C:33-7(b)(2).
5. State, Div. of State Police v. New Jersey State Trooper Captains Ass’n - N.J.S. 34:13A-3 – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to modify the statutory language of N.J.S. 34:13A-3(f) in response to the Court’s determination that, generally, State Police Captains are not deemed to be managerial executives and may be included in collective negotiations.
