### **COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA**

1. “Residence” for Purposes of Sex Offender Registration - Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report regarding proposed modification of N.J.S. 2C:7-2 to deal with the registration of secondary addresses in response to *State v. Halloran*, 446 N.J. Super. 381 (Law Div. 2014) that incorporates additional research and proposed statutory language as directed by the Commission.

2. Suspended License - Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report proposing modifications of the language of N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b) to clarify that an individual who operates a motor vehicle beyond the determinate sentence term of suspension, but before reinstatement, should not be charged with a violation of the criminal law.

3. Public Assistance Law - Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report regarding Public Assistance that represents a revision of the Commission’s 2009 Final Report on this subject.

4. Guardianship - Consideration of a Memorandum reviewing the status of New Jersey guardianship law and updating the Commission regarding the research conducted to this time.

5. Out-of-State DWI - Consideration of a Memorandum recommending conclusion of the project regarding whether out-of-state DWIs should qualify as predicate convictions pursuant to N.J.S. 2C:40-26 as a result of Legislative activity in this area.

6. Municipal Vacancy Law – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to identify possible changes to the Municipal Vacancy Law in order to improve its organization and effectiveness.

7. Open Public Records Act – Security Camera Footage – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to address the issues reviewed by the New Jersey Supreme Court in *Gilleran v. Township of Bloomfield*, 227 N.J. 159 (2016).
